In the coming weeks, greater emphasis will be placed on early recovery and restoration of social welfare services.</p> <p><i>Earthquake Facts</i> (as at 11 April) Death toll: 13,127 people Injured: 4,793 people Missing: 14,348 people 127,817 people remain in evacuation centres, with many more staying with friends and extended families. Over 7000 schools have been destroyed or significantly damaged.</p>
